Export Service Standards

Uplift of full containers

- For Fergusson uplifts we require timeframes and dates accompanied by the pre-advice or documentation two working days in advance of uplift date. This is so that we can get VBS' as required to gate into the port. For Monday uplifts, we require three working days.
- Containers that are required to be uplifted in the morning for Fergusson port must be accessible from 6am in order to guarantee we get the VBS that is required. We can only accept cut-off 12pm containers without access from 6am on best endeavours.
- Metroport exports must have documentation or pre-advice sent through on the day prior to uplift to ensure we can make a booking on time.
- Loaded containers for Multi-Cargo port require a standard carters' note and signed VGM document to be sent to us. We cannot take containers into port without these documents
- VGM via our conweigh service needs to be arranged the day prior to our uplift in order to give us and them sufficient time to organize our schedules appropriately. Same day conweigh may lead to us missing our opportunity
